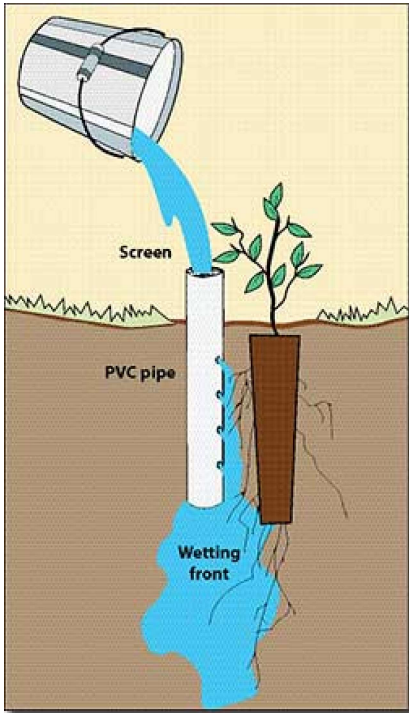


We operate drip irrigation systems three days per week for 15 minutes each time. Adjust up or down based on your microclimate. If grasses are droopy and falling over, you are over watering.

For the plants that do not require supplemental water you may need to hand water them 3-4 times the first summer to aid in establishment.

OPTIONAL - Install Watering tubes when you plant your plants (see below). Watering tubes are 6-8 inch long pieces of  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pvc. Watering tubes allow hand watering or drip irrigation water to reach the roots of the plants without watering the surface of the soils which causes weed seed germination.



Note: we do not drill holes into the pvc watering tubes and we don't install screens. If you are worried about bugs getting into the tubes a little piece of steel wool in the top of the tube will prevent this.
