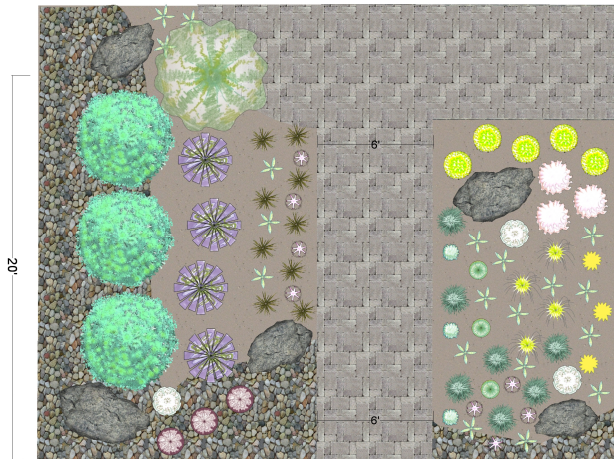

Heritage Garden Planting Plan - Prepared by Kelsey Kelmel,
Benton Conservation District 4/2026

 =2-4" Layer of river rock. Avoid plastic weed barrier.
Opt for Burlap or cardboard underneath!

This planting plan is provided as an inspirational guide in establishing your Heritage Garden and/or low water-use landscape. This drawing does not constitute a professional landscape design, all property lines and dimensions are approximate. Always call 811 to determine the location of buried lines before you dig. Large Rocks have been added to help create structure and microclimates for plants. Pathways should be constructed of material that provides a stable walking surface (ex. crushed basalt). Weed control should be conducted prior to planting to insure a suitable planting bed. Supplemental irrigation is required for plants that have a water requirement greater than <10 inches.
